

## **GUIDELINES FOR Abstract Submission**

# 51st Annual Meeting of the Swiss Society of Nephrology (5-6.12.19)

## **Submission Information**

The abstracts must be submitted electronically through the SSN abstract submission tool (https://amssn2019.exordo.com) for consideration.

There is no limit to the number of abstracts that an individual may submit. Hard copy abstracts (sent by email, fax or post) will not be considered.

## Abstract structure - please adhere to these rules

Language: Abstracts should be submitted in English only

**Title:** Do not use capital letters

Abstracts resulting from an NCCR project must be labelled with "(NCCR

project)" at the end of the title.

Authors: Author and co-authors first names and family names (e.g. Marcus Smith); there is

no limit on the authors allowed

**Affiliation**: Affiliation details of all authors must contain (in this order):

Department, Institution/Hospital, City, Country

**Abstract body:** The body of the abstract must be uploaded as text document and is limited to 300

words (title, authors and tables/figures do not count).

Organize it as follows:

Background: A statement of the purpose and the hypothesis of the study.

Methods: A concise description of the methods used.

Results: A summary of the results presented in just enough detail to

support the conclusions.

Conclusions: A statement of the conclusions reached based on the presented

data.

**Tables/Figures:** A maximum of three (3) is possible and must be submitted separately ("jpg", "gif",

"bmp" or "png" are acceptable formats) in black and white only. As a rule the

table/figure is placed after the results.

Other: Use only standard abbreviations. Use generic names of drugs. Express numbers as

numerals.

**Deadline for Submission** 

**Submission of your abstract will be possible until <u>Sunday, September 8, 2019</u> at 11.59 p.m. CET - sorry absolutely no prolongation possible!** 

Please understand that abstracts submitted after this deadline is no longer considered.

You can edit your abstract until this deadline.

## **Registration to the SGN-SSN Annual meeting**

The presenting authors of all accepted abstracts must register for the Annual Meeting <u>online here</u>. If the presenting author is not registered he/she will not be allowed to present the poster or oral presentation.

#### **Abstract Review Process**

All abstracts will be reviewed by the SGN-SSN Scientific Committee. Based on several criteria (originality of the project, quality of methods and results, interest of the conclusion, etc.) an overall quality score is assigned to each abstract which serves as the basis for the ranking of an individual abstract.

Please note that the number of oral presentations is limited.

The choice of format (oral presentation / poster) is determined by the Scientific Committee.

## **Notification of Acceptance**

Notification of acceptance will be sent to you by e-mail **in week 40**. *Please check your SPAM mail on regular intervals as some of our mails may end in there!* 

### **Short Note on Oral Presentations**

Unless otherwise stated, the time slot for oral presentations is **10 minutes (8 minutes presentation and 2 minutes discussion)**. Please note that only digital material will be allowed for presentations (please use an USB stick). Oral presentations must be given in English. A speaker center will be at your disposal, where you can prepare your presentation.

### **Short Note on Poster Presentations**

All posters will be considered for the poster award of the SGN-SSN annual meeting. The evaluation of the posters by the Poster Prize Jury will take place during the poster walk on **Thursday December 5**, **2019**, **from 17h45 to 18h30 in the poster area**. The poster format is DIN A0 (120cm x 85cm) (height x width). The poster needs to be written in English.

## Withdrawal of your abstract
