INTERNAL RULES SCIENTIFIC COMMISSION

Commission of the Swiss Society of Nephrology (Unanimously approved at the GA of 8.12.2017 / Freiburg)

Description of the commission

Scientific Commission

Preamble

Each commission prepares internal rules, which must be submitted to the SSN Board for approval. Each Commission is under the *responsibility* of the SSN.

Aim / mission of the commission

- Participate in the promotion of basic and clinical scientific research, in the field of Nephrology in Switzerland.
- Encourage communication between the research teams in Switzerland and international collaboration.
- Establish contacts with other academic societies to promote multi-disciplinary research.
- Establish the jury and analyze records of the candidates to the scientific prices or grants that the SSN endorses.
- Establish, in partnership with the Organizing Committee, the scientific program of the Swiss Society of Nephrology meetings.
- Create focus groups to address specific issues and submit proposals to the Committee.
- Foster the partnership with industry to improve the opportunities for support of scientific projects.

Definition of the interaction

The Commission reports directly to the SSN Board

Structure of the commission (chair, vice-chair, number of members)

A president from the academic world is appointed for 2 years, 2 x renewable.

The president is member of the SSN Board.

In addition to the president, 6 members represent the diversity of the basic and clinical research in Switzerland. 2-year mandate, renewable terms are 2 times.

Election mode of the commission members

The members of this committee are elected by absolute majority vote at the SSN General Assembly for a term of office of 2 years and are eligible for re-election twice.

Length of mandate

2 years, renewable twice / max. 6 years

Number of commission Members

The commission is composed by a maximum of 10 members, which must be SSN members. Exceptions are possible.

Internal vote modalities

Majority vote of the members present. In case of tie vote the vote of the President is decisive.

Number of meetings per year

As often as requested, but at least one per year

Minutes of meetings

14 days for writing and 14 days for approval.

Should reach the SSN Board within max. 30 days after meeting.

Diffusion of information and of publications by commissions

All publications and notifications are to be submitted to the SSN Board.

Commission decisions and recommendations are open to all SSN members (website or mailings)

Mandatory yearly report to GA

Each Commission will submit an annual report at the ordinary SSN general meeting of members.

To be submitted to the SSN Office in writing by each end of October

Admission as Commission or dissolution

The General Assembly of the SSN decides about admission or dissolution of Commission upon proposal by the SSN Board

Distribution of communications

All SSN communications are after consultation with the SSN president or secretary, exclusively sent via the Administration
