- Abstract submission** Before submitting your abstract please read the Guidelines as below.
- Online abstract tool** Proceed to <https://sgn2022.exordo.com> where you will be required to setup an account first.  
There is no limit to the number of abstracts that an individual may submit. Hard copy abstracts (sent by email, fax or post) will not be considered.
- Abstract structure** **Please adhere to these rules**
- Language: Abstracts should be submitted in English only
- Title: Do not use capital letters
- Authors: Author and co-authors first names and family names (e.g. Marcus Smith); there is no limit on the authors allowed
- Affiliation: Affiliation details of all authors **must** contain (in this order): Department, Institution/Hospital, **City**, Country
- Abstract body:  
The body of the abstract must be uploaded as text document and is limited to 300 words (title, authors and tables/figures **do not** count).
- Organize it as follows:
- 1) FOR AN ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**
- \* *Background*: A statement of the purpose and the hypothesis of the study.
  - \* *Methods*: A concise description of the methods used.
  - \* *Results*: A summary of the results presented in just enough detail to support the conclusions.
  - \* *Conclusions*: A statement of the conclusions reached based on the presented data.
- 2) FOR A CASE REPORT**
- \* *Background*: A statement of the purpose and the hypothesis of the case.
  - \* *Case description*: A description of the case.
  - \* *Learning point*: A summary of the learning points.
  - \* *Conclusions*: if you have no conclusion, please write "n/a" in this section.
- Tables/Figures: A maximum of one (1) is possible and must be submitted separately ("jpg", "gif", "bmp" or "png" are acceptable formats) in black and white only. As a rule the table/figure is placed after the results.
- Other: Use only standard abbreviations. Use generic names of drugs. Express numbers as numerals.

<b>YSN Authors</b>	<p><b>Abstracts*</b> submitted by YSN authors (<b>&lt; 40 years old</b>) can apply to participate in the "<b>Young Swiss Nephrology Award</b>": please, answer "YES" to the additional question. The first author will be asked to mention his/her date of birth. The 4 best papers will have the possibility to present their work as Oral Presentation during the YSN Session, on Thursday, December 8, at 17.50-18.40 in Room A. One of them will be awarded "<b>Young (&lt;40 yo) Swiss Nephrology Award 2022</b>" with a prize money award.</p> <p><i>* this does not apply to case reports</i></p>

<b>Abstract Review Process</b>	<p>All abstracts will be reviewed by the SGN-SSN Scientific Committee. Based on several criteria (originality of the project, quality of methods and results, interest of the conclusion, etc.) an overall quality score is assigned to each abstract which serves as the basis for the ranking of an individual abstract.</p>
<b>Confirmation of receipt</b>	<p>If you do not receive a confirmation of receipt within two business days of submission, please email the <a href="#">SSN Congress Office</a> straightaway. Lack of email confirmation indicates that we did not receive the submission.</p>
<b>Notification of acceptance</b>	<p>Notification of acceptance will be sent to you by e-mail in week <b>40</b>. Please check your SPAM mail on regular intervals if you do not receive the notification!</p>
<b>Registration to the SGN-SSN Annual Meeting</b>	<p>The <b>presenting</b> author of all accepted abstracts must register for the Annual Meeting and pay the appropriate registration fees. If the presenting author is not registered he/she will not be allowed to present.</p> <p><a href="#">Online Registration</a></p>
<b>Abstract editing</b>	<p>You can edit <b>and</b> withdraw your abstract (status "<i>submitted</i>" and "<i>pending</i>") until September 11, 2022 at 11.59 p.m. CET</p>
<b>How to edit my abstract?</b>	<p>In just a few easy steps you can edit the abstract.  <a href="#">Follow description</a></p>
<b>I have forgotten my password</b>	<p>Go to the log in address, enter your email, press the return button on your keyboard and click 'Forgot my password'. You will receive an email with information on how to proceed.</p>

<b>Format of acceptance</b>	The authors of all accepted abstracts will present their work <b>orally</b> and are expected to attend the meeting <b>in person</b> . The abstract will be attributed to different session by the Organizing Committee of the congress as such:
<b>Power pitch format AND Poster format</b>	<b>The power pitch session</b> is designated to stimulate the discussion on posters. Each speaker will present the essence of his work in 3-minute presentation, followed by 2-minute discussion. <b>The abstracts selected for this session will be also presented as classical printed-out posters.</b> The poster format is DIN A0 (120cm x 85cm) (height x width). The best poster will be awarded with a dedicated prize.
<b>Elevator pitch format</b>	Selected case reports will be presented in the <b>“elevator pitch” format</b> , an innovative, dynamic presentation format aiming at the active interaction with the public.
<b>Oral presentation</b>	The time slot for <b>classical oral presentation</b> is 9 minutes (7-minute presentation and 2-minute discussion).
<b>Pecha-Kucha storytelling format</b>	Selected abstracts will be presented in the innovative <b>Pecha-Kucha storytelling format</b> (more about this format: <a href="http://www.pechakucha.com/about">www.pechakucha.com/about</a> ).
<b>YSN Presentations</b>	The 4 YSN selected abstracts will also be presented in the innovative <b>Pecha-Kucha storytelling format</b> (more about this format: <a href="http://www.pechakucha.com/about">www.pechakucha.com/about</a> ).
<b>Notification of format</b>	The authors will be notified in advance about the format of their presentation by the organizing committee. They will receive information on the specific format for an optimal preparation of their presentation. Please, note that only digital material will be allowed for presentation (please, use an USB stick). A speaker center will be at disposal to upload your presentation.
<b>Language</b>	All oral and poster presentations must be given in English.
<b>Withdrawal of your abstract</b>	If you wish to withdraw your abstract or if you are unable to attend the meeting immediately inform the <a href="#">SSN Congress Office</a> . Please indicate the exact title & authors of the abstract. After submission deadline, withdrawal requests will be accepted on a case-by-case basis, <u>but the abstract may still appear in meeting publications.</u>
